2024/25 Year 9 Trip Programme

Alexandra Palace for ice skating on Tuesday, 17th December.

Arrangements for the day would be as follows:

- Students will meet in the school canteen at 9:50 am to leave the school premises at approximately 10:00 am and walk to the Telford Road bus stop to catch the 184 bus to Bedford Road Palace Gates Road. We will then walk through Alexandra Palace Park up to the ice rink.
- Students will be accompanied by members of staff who will stay with students at all times during travel and in the ice rink.
- Students should bring a packed lunch. If your child is Free School Meals, lunch will be provided. Students will be given an opportunity before and after the ice skating to have their lunch before returning to school.
- Students will accompany staff on the same bus route to return to school and be dismissed from school at approximately 3:15 pm
- Students must arrive in school in their full PE kit. **Students may need to bring with** them extra clothing suitable for ice skating.
- During the visit, Year 9 students are representing Laurel Park School and are expected to uphold the high expectations of behaviour that they present in school. We reserve the right to say students cannot attend should we believe they will not uphold the values of the school.
