**Re: London Cultural Experience Trip to Central London**

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you of an exciting opportunity for our students to experience the rich culture and history of London on Tuesday, 17th December. We have organised a school trip to Central London, specifically designed to enhance our students' understanding of the city's heritage and landmarks.

The day's itinerary promises to be both educational and enjoyable. We will begin with a visit to the iconic London Eye, which will provide students with a panoramic view of the capital's skyline. Following this, we will embark on a circular sightseeing boat cruise along the famous River Thames, allowing students to observe some of London's most popular landmarks from the water.

Please ensure that your child wears a full school uniform for the trip, as this is part of our school's policy. Additionally, students may bring no more than £20 for any souvenirs or snacks they wish to purchase during the day.

Payment for the trip is now available through ParentPay, and we kindly ask that all payments are made by the deadline of Thursday, 12th December 2024. **Please note that the school may remove a student from all, or some educational visits due to poor behaviour. In these circumstances a refund will not be given.**
