Year 7 Target setting and GO4Schools

We use target grades at Laurel Park School to help us monitor the progress and attainment of our pupils.

The targets are set using the results of the KS2 tests that pupils completed at the end of year 6 . For pupils who do not have KS2 data, we generate targets using CAT test data and reading test data.

The target grades represent the minimum grade we expect pupils to achieve.

When pupils complete assessments we will compare the grade they achieved in the assessment with their target grade and this will help us ensure they continue to make the best possible progress and achieve at the highest possible level.

Grades

In Key Stage 3 the following grades are used to show base target and current grade:

<u>Target</u>	<u>Explanation</u>
Developing D1 , D2 , D3	KS2 data suggests the pupil is working below age-related expectations.
Developing D4	KS2 data suggests the pupil is working just below age-related expectation.
Secure S5, S6	KS2 data shows the the pupil is working in line with age-related expectations
Exceeding E7,E8, E9	KS2 data shows the pupil is working above age-related expectations.

Parents and carers can view the target grades for their child, along with attendance data and their timetable in GO4Schools.


